ORDINANCE 0.2117-2021

EXPLANATION: An Ordinance authorizing a lease for storage of Township vehicles and equipment

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON AUTHORIZING A LEASE OF CERTAIN PREMISES LOCATED AT 212 DURHAM AVENUE, IN THE BOROUGH OF METUCHEN, NEW JERSEY, FOR STORAGE OF MUNICIPAL VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE AGREEMENT ASSOCIATED THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Metuchen Acquisition Realty, LLC is the owner of certain premises located at 212 Durham Avenue, in the Borough of Metuchen (the "Premises); and

WHEREAS, the Premises consists of approximately 9,975 square feet of space; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "Township") has an immediate, emergent need of temporary storage for its vehicles and equipment during the winter season, and wishes to acquire an interest in the Premises by way of a lease agreement with Metuchen Acquisition Realty, LLC, effective on or about December 1, 2021 in order to provide for storage for such vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Lease Agreement shall be on a monthly basis, not to exceed four (4) months, at a monthly rental amount of \$8,911.00 gross for the Premises, which includes all utilities; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Lands and Buildings Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-1 <u>et seq.</u>, and specifically, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-5(a)(1), authorizes a municipality, by ordinance, to provide for the acquisition of any real property by purchase or lease; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the foregoing, the Mayor and Township Council wish to authorize the execution of a Lease Agreement, effective on or about December 1, 2021, with Metuchen Acquisition Realty, LLC, on behalf of the Township, for the public purposes set forth above, in a form satisfactory to the Township Attorney.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, and the Township Clerk to attest, a Lease Agreement between the Township of Edison and Metuchen Acquisition Realty, LLC regarding the Premises, so that the Township may rent the Premises for the public purposes referenced above. Said Lease Agreement shall be consistent with the representations referenced above, and shall be in a form satisfactory to the Township Attorney.
- 2. The Lease Agreement shall be effective on or about December 1, 2021.
- 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with all applicable laws.

ORDINANCE 0.2118-2021

EXPLANATION: An Ordinance amending the Township Code Chapter 37, "Zoning," Schedule A, "Schedule of Area, Yard and Building Requirements," to increase the minimum lot requirements for the G-C Golf Course – Natural Preservation District.

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "**Township**") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township Code of General Ordinances (the "Code") provides rules, regulations and standards to conserve the value of property and encourage the most appropriate use of land in the Township, pursuant to Chapter 37 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend Chapter 37, Schedule A of the Code, entitled "Schedule of Area, Yard and Building Requirements," to increase the minimum lot requirements for the G-C Golf Course – Natural Preservation District, as referenced in Chapter 37-46.5 therein; and

WHEREAS, prior to the Municipal Council hearing on the adoption of this Ordinance, it shall be referred to the Township Planning Board, as required by *N.J.S.A.* 40:55D-64 and *N.J.S.A.* 40:55D-26 of the Municipal Land Use Law (the "**MLUL**"); and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Township ("**Municipal Council**") has determined to amend Subchapter 37-30.2 of the Code to read as follows (additions are <u>underlined</u> and deletions are in [brackets]):

Schedule A Schedule of Area, Yard and Building Requirements Attached as Exhibit A

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Municipal Council hereby amends Chapter 37, Schedule A, "Schedule of Area, Yard and Building Requirements," as set forth herein, and more specifically, attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> hereto.
- 3. Upon introduction and prior to the Municipal Council hearing on adoption, the Township Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy of the within Ordinance to the Township Planning Board for review in accordance with the MLUL.
- 4. It is the intent of the Municipal Council to incorporate the additions, amendments and/or supplements contained in this Ordinance into the Code. All of the remaining provisions in Chapter 37 of the Code shall remain unchanged and have full force and legal effect.
- 5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
 - 6. A copy of this Ordinance shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.

7. This Ordinance shall take effect after twenty (20) days of its final passage by the Municipal Council, upon approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, as permitted by N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32, Township Code Section 5-7(d) also authorizes the return of property taxes for the current year and prior year but not greater than for a twenty-four (24) month period in the aggregate, or, should the Veteran's Administration determine that a veteran's disability date is greater than twenty-four (24) months from the date the applicant submits his/her application with the Tax Assessor's office, the Township will only be obligated to return taxes for a period of no greater than twenty-four (24) months from receipt of a completed application to the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Township Code Section 5-7(d) the listed applicants are also due a refund of property taxes paid from the effective date of the determination; and the Tax Collector has reviewed the applications, approvals and taxes paid and recommends that the listed applicants are entitled to receive refund of paid taxes in the amount indicated on the attached list.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, that the aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

*Recommendation #1:

Description: That the Police and Fire divisions report their "official" records of sick and vacation days to the Human Resources office in order to have all records in a central location and to be integrated into the financial/human resources module (Edmunds) software.

Analysis: The Police Department utilizes a special program to set schedules and manage attendance (Police Officer Scheduling System – POSS) which has not been integrated into the Edmunds module. The Fire Department maintains their own original records.

Corrective Action: Effective January 1, 2021 the Township will be the implementing Unicorn HRO platform for processing payroll and managing human resource functions. The Police POSS system is being integrated into Unicorn HRO.

Effective July 1, 2021 the Fire Department time has been integrated into the Unicorn HR/Payroll System. Sick and vacation is centralized for the Human Resources office to have records of sick and vacation balances.

Implementation Date: July 1, 2021 – Fire Department is integrated in the Unicorn System. The police department still in implementation and is scheduled to launch 2021.

*Recommendation #2:

Description: That the Township reviews its policy with regards to adequately budgeting the appropriate amount for employee health benefits.

Analysis: The Township self-insures its health benefit programs which are administered by third parties. The Township also maintains an additional reserve fund in the event current budget year appropriations do not adequately cover claims liability.

Corrective Action: Absent state-imposed health benefits cost reforms, the Township needs to increase reserves and appropriations funding employee and retiree health benefits.

Implementation Date: Funding and Reserve levels will continue to be closely monitored. Additional funding will be requested for the 2022 Municipal Budget.

Recommendation #3:

Description: That the Township collect all required employment forms and return these forms as part of the employee's personnel files.

Analysis: Conclusion of analysis of a random sampling produced some missing documents of W4 and I-9 forms not yet placed in the employee's personnel folder.
