ORDINANCE 0.2134-2022

EXPLANATION: Ordinance accepting dedication of the roadway formerly known as 100 & 106 Ethel Road, Block 20, Lots 4F & 4M associated with Application #P5129, and now known as Plenge Court, and authorizing an Agreement between the Township and DCK Developers, LLC in connection therewith

WHEREAS, in April of 2011, DCK Developers, LLC (the "Contractor") posted among other performance security a Cash Performance Bond by Check #6759601304 in the amount of \$23,668.20, to guarantee in part the installation of improvements for the project located at 100 & 107 Ethel Road, Block 20, Lots 4F & 4M within the Township of Edison ("Township"), and now known as Plenge Court (referred to as the "Roadway", and the overall project as the "Development"); and

WHEREAS the Township has received a request from the Contractor to reduce the posted Cash Performance Bond to reflect the work completed in connection with the Development; and

WHEREAS the Township Division of Engineering has made an inspection of the project site in connection with the Development, and has determined that the top coarse of the pavement on the Roadway was unsatisfactory; and

WHEREAS following further discussion between the Parties, the Contractor has agreed to forfeit its Cash Performance Bond, and its ownership of the Roadway, to the Township, in consideration of the Township's agreement to complete the top coarse of the pavement on Plenge Court and the Roadway, take dedicated ownership thereof, and to issue a certificate of occupancy for the last home to be built in connection with the Development; and

WHEREAS to memorialize the forgoing, in addition to this Ordinance the parties have agreed to the terms of a certain Cash Performance Bond Forfeiture Agreement ("Agreement"), which is annexed hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:67-1(a), the Township may make, amend, repeal and enforce ordinances ascertaining and establishing the boundaries of all streets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:67-1(b), the Township is authorized to accept the dedication of streets; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to accept the dedication for roadway purposes a portion of the property currently owned by DCK Developers, LLC as Contractor, located at 100 & 107 Ethel Road, Block 20, Lots 4F & 4M within the Township, and now known as Plenge Court (again, the "Roadway"), all as further set forth in Exhibit B herein and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:67-2, a copy of any ordinance accepting the dedication of any street or portion thereof, with a map showing the location, bounds and dimensions thereof, shall be filed in the office where the conveyance of lands are recorded in the county in which the municipality is situated; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to accept the right-of-way dedication subject to review and approval of the right-of-way dedication by the Township Engineer, and also, wishes to approve of the Agreement in connection therewith. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

2. Subject to the review and approval by the Township Engineer, the Township accepts the dedication of the Roadway (Plenge Court), as further set forth in Exhibit B, including all utilities and improvements installed therein, as part of the public road system of the Township.

3. The Township Engineer is authorized and directed to inspect the subject roadway and to determine whether the roadway is constructed in conformance with all applicable Township regulations.

4. The Mayor and Township Clerk, and any other necessary Township personnel, be and hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver any document, including the Agreement attached as Exhibit A, and any other instruments to effectuate the intentions hereof, and, together with the Township's officials and consultants, to take any and all necessary steps as would be reasonable or necessary to effectuate said acceptance and to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

5. The introduction of this Ordinance shall be advertised pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:49-2; provided, however, that notice as to introduction and public hearing shall be made, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40:49-6, at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing and adoption hereof.

6. Notice of the introduction of this Ordinance and the time and place when and where this Ordinance will be further considered for public hearing and final passage, including a copy of this Ordinance, shall be mailed to every person whose lands may be affected by this Ordinance, so far as same may be ascertained, directed to the last known post-office address, in accordance with the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40:49-6.

7. Within sixty (60) days after adoption of this Ordinance, the Township Clerk shall cause this Ordinance, certified by her, under the seal of the municipality to be filed in the office wherein conveyances of lands are recorded in the County of Middlesex.

8. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON TO CONDUCT A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PROPOSED STUDY AREA, WHICH INCLUDES THE PROPERTIES IDENTIFIED AS BLOCK 1122, LOTS 1.A AND 24.C, BLOCK 160.U, LOTS 50 AND BLOCK 160.C, LOT 18.01 QUALIFY AS A CONDEMNATION AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 ET. SEQ.

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, NJSA 40A: 12A-1 et seq (the "Redevelopment Law") provides a mechanism to empower and assist local governments in efforts to promote programs of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Law sets forth the procedures for local governments to declare an area in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "Township") desires to explore whether certain real property identified on the Township's official tax maps as Block 1122, Lots 1.A and 24.C, Block 160.U, Lot 50 and Block 160.C, Lot 18.01(the "Study Area") qualify as a Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment" under the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6</u>, prior to making a determination that the Study Area qualifies as an "area in need of redevelopment," the Township Council, by resolution, must authorize the Township Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation (the "Preliminary Investigation") to determine whether the Study Area qualifies as a "Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment " in accordance with the criteria set forth in <u>N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5</u>; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Township and its residents to authorize and direct the Planning Board to conduct a Preliminary Investigation to determine whether the Study Area qualifies pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A. 40A: 12A-5</u>.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Edison that the Planning Board is hereby authorized and directed to conduct a Preliminary Investigation to determine whether the following properties, hereinafter referred to as the "Study Area" meets the criteria for designation as a Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5</u>:

- a. Block 1122, Lots 1.A(2080 Route 27),
- b. Block 1122, Lot 24.C (2068 Route 27),
- c. Block 160.U, Lot 50 (2 Schuyler Drive) and,
- d. Block 160.C, Lot18.01 (1810 Route 27)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in conducting the preliminary investigation of the Study Area the Planning Board and shall act in accordance with the procedures set forth in <u>N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6</u> and shall submit its findings and recommendations to the Township Council in the form of a resolution and supporting documentation in accordance with the Redevelopment Law.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$17,000.00 FROM LYONDELL BASELL FOR THE PURCHASE OF A GEAR EXTRACTOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison, County of Middlesex (the "**Township**") is a public body corporate and politic, and municipal corporation, of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Lyondell Basell ("Lyondell") has offered to donate to the Township, for the use of the Township Fire Department, the aggregate sum of \$17,000.00, for the purchase of a gear extractor, which is a type of washing machine to clean firefighters' gear after a fire, or after being in a hazardous materials incident (the "Donated Funds"); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29, within the Fiscal Affairs Law, provides:

Any local unit is authorized and empowered to accept bequests, legacies and gifts made to it and is empowered to utilize such bequests, legacies and gifts in the manner set forth in the conditions of the bequest, legacy or gift, provided, however, that such bequest, legacy or gift shall not be put to any use which is inconsistent with the laws of this State and of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to accept the Donated Funds from Lyondell for the purchase of a gear extractor, all as aforementioned; and

WHEREAS, the Township, in order to effectuate the acceptance of the Donated Funds for the purposes expressed above, is agreeable to executing documents reasonably necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution, including without limit such forms of Acknowledgment of Charitable Contribution as may be reasonably agreed upon with Lyondell; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison thanks and appreciates the generosity of Lyondell in connection with the donation of the Donated Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Council of the Township of Edison, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

2. The Township hereby accepts the donation of the Donated Funds from Lyondell, for the purpose of purchasing a gear extractor for the Township Fire Department, all as stated above.

3. The Mayor of the Township, the Township Administrator, and other reasonably necessary personnel, are hereby authorized and directed to execute any documents reasonably necessary to effectuate the Township's acceptance of the donation of the Donated Funds, including without limit such forms of Acknowledgment of Charitable Contribution as may be reasonably agreed upon with Lyondell.

4. If any part of this Resolution shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Resolution.

5. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.

6. This Resolution shall take effect as provided by law.
